

FEARLESS March 1st. 2020

On Sunday, Gerry explained our #1 question for God is "Do You love me?", while His first question for us is "Do you *trust* Me?" Discuss with your LifeGroup the relationship between our love for God as it relates to the level of trust we have in Him

Read Hebrews 11:1, Genesis 15:6. Faith is assurance, conviction, belief & utterly trusting in God. Faith is essential to Christians, both to enter the kingdom of God & to experience Jesus through His Spirit. On Sunday, Gerry defined faith as: *faith is trusting the Triune God with my entire life in responsive obedience to who He is, what He does & what He says.*

Faith is trust. When we trust God it is to fully believe in, lean on, place full weight upon and rest in. It involves our intellect, emotion, will, heart. On a scale of 1 to 10, with 1 being *often skeptical* & 10 being *fearless*, how do you rate your trust in God?

Faith is trusting the triune God. We trust our triune God: God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit. Do you trust who He is? Do you trust what He does - His leadership, wisdom, will, authority, purpose? Do you trust what He says, as you listen to Him or through His Word? Do you trust each Person of our triune Godhead?

Faith is trusting the triune God with my entire life. Read Proverbs 3:5-6. We trust God with our entire life. Often, we can hold back & do not fully surrender control. Sometimes we can hold back in our spirit, mind, body, relationships, time &/or money. Are there areas of your life you find difficult to surrender to God? What part(s) of your life do you struggle to entrust to His leadership?

Faith is trusting the triune God with my entire life in responsive obedience. Trust in God manifests itself in responsive obedience. How is faith displayed in my life? Share stories of where you fearlessly demonstrate faith in God.

Faith is trusting the Triune God with my entire life in responsive obedience to who He is, what He does & what He says. God is trustworthy and promises an eternal good result. Share stories together of God's faithfulness to you from your own life.
