Reflection Questions

- How significant is a song of deliverance in your walk with God? How can you really learn to walk in victory even through the valleys and shadows?
- Where is the Spirit of God instructing you in the way you should go? What obstacles need to be removed before you are prepared to accomplish the task at hand?

Prayer Prompts

- Teach me to rejoice in the truth with godly sincerity with God and others.
- For a heart that is broken and contrite in times of trespass against God.
- To learn to praise the LORD even when my heart feels overwhelmed.
- A heart of devotion and faithfulness to respond to the voice of God.

- Who is the Spirit of the Lord calling you to share Hope with? How can you share your faith with others with more gentleness and respect?
- When have you been slandered for your good behaviour? What was your response to the person, and how did the Spirit of the Lord intervene?

Prayer Prompts

- To bless those who curse me and pray for those who persecute me.
- For brotherly and sisterly love to be shown within the family of God.
- For zealousness for the house of the Lord and to do what is good.
- A willingness to suffer for righteousness' sake for the honour of God.

- Spirit of God, how can I keep my tongue from evil?
- Where do I need to turn from evil and do good?
