Position Objective

Summit Camps is looking for high capacity Camper Program Leader who is passionate about providing fun & engaging camp activities & aiding our camp directors & NextGen Pastoral Leadership team run camp programs that see children & youth grow in their leadership & character skills, as well as come to know Jesus & grow in their relationship with Him. We are committed to teaching God's truth, inviting kids to connect and respond to Jesus and providing a loving & irresistible environment for our campers & LITs to know & intentionally follow Jesus, grow in their leadership skills and make a positive impact in their community & world.

The 2024 Camper Program Leader will work together and in collaboration with our camp directors to assist in preparing, administering, leading & supervising all camp activities, electives, special days & programming. Together, under the supervision & guidance of the NextGen Pastoral Leadership team and camp directors, the Camper Program Leader will provide camper aid & support to Crew Leads and LITs throughout the Summit Camps experience.

Key Responsibilities

The 2024 Camp Program Leads will work in collaboration with the NextGen Pastoral Leadership Team & 2024 Camp Director in the preparation, operation, administration & supervision of all camp programs. These tasks & responsibilities include:

ADMINISTRATION & COMMUNICATION

- Connecting with parents & guardians throughout camp weeks & at the end of week celebrations
- Assisting with check-in & check-out zones before, during & after camp
- Taking inventory of camp resources & equipment
- Attending, assisting & representing the Summit Camps team at local events, fairs / festivals, markets & other community or Church events to promote Summit Camps alongside the camp team and NextGen Pastoral Leadership team

PLANNING & PROGRAMMING SUPPORT

- Participating in camp skits, music videos, teaching videos, or other videos for camp programming & promotional use
- Assisting the 2024 Camp Director in preparing, organizing & circulating elective, Bible lesson or activity materials
- Setting up wide games, electives, crew times and other camp activities or special days
- Assisting in running the end of week family celebrations
- Leading & teaching a variety of camp activities, electives & wide games

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT & SUPERVISION

- Ensuring the safety of all campers by taking roll call at activities & maintaining camper attendance lists throughout the day
- Assisting Crew Leaders with camper aid
- Supporting Crew Leaders with assignment coverage or LIT management as needed
- Working with the camp directors & NextGen Pastoral Leadership team to develop opportunities for LITs to lead or grow in their leadership throughout camp programs

ENVIRONMENTAL PRACTICES & IRRESISTIBLE ENVIRONMENTS

- Collaborating with all staff to create & set up camp decorations
- Reporting any camp hazards or broken equipment to the camp directors or NextGen Pastoral Leadership team
- Collaborating with the NextGen Pastoral Leadership team, 2024 Camp Director & 2024 LIT Director to schedule staff, volunteers & LITs to participate in an environmental care plan including measures & best practices for recycling, compost & food/waste management, as well as grounds clean up, gardening & property stewardship

OTHER DUTIES & AD-HOC

- Ability to uphold Summit Community Church's mission, vision, values, guidelines & team handbook
- Additional duties & ad-hoc responsibilities may be assigned as objectives are determined
